#### **REGULATIONS**

- 1. The following registered breeds will be recognized:
  - a. Registered Angus, Beefmaster, Brahman, Brangus, Charolais, Hereford, Limousin, Maine Anjou, Red Angus, Santa Gertrudis, Shorthorn and Simmental
  - b. Registered Composite Charolais Plus, Lim-Flex, Maintainer, Shorthorn Plus, SimSolution
  - c. All other registered breeds will compete in AOB categories.
- 2. All animals must be halter broken and will be shown at halter. No pen judging.
- 3. Market steers must be owned by current rules set forth by the Perry County Fair Association.
- 4. Bulls 6 months and older must be shown with a nose ring (temporary or permanent).
- 5. There will be registered and commercial divisions for females.
- 6. Only registered bulls will show.
- 7. Exhibitors must show cattle without assistance.
